1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-407.01, to read:
4 16-407.01. Election administration; private monies prohibited
5 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THIS STATE AND A CITY, TOWN, COUNTY,
6 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR OTHER PUBLIC BODY THAT CONDUCTS OR ADMINISTERS
7 ELECTIONS MAY NOT RECEIVE OR EXPEND PRIVATE MONIES FOR PREPARING FOR,
8 ADMINISTERING OR CONDUCTING AN ELECTION, INCLUDING REGISTERING VOTERS.
